
Create a copy layer to work on -Layer-Duplicate

Rather Crude




"LEVELS"

Eye dropper to set exposure points




"CURVES"

Colour Options


Very powerful, rather complicated

-Image- Adjustments-Exposure



"SHADOWS/ HIGHLIGHTS"


-Image- Adjustments-Shadows/Highlights

Could be useful




"COLOUR BALANCE"

A useful tool




"HUE/SATURATION"

-Image- Adjustments- Vibrance


Very, very complicated

Image- Adjustments- Channel Mixer Very, very complicated




LOCAL AREAS TOOLS
