


# To Transfer Photos from your Camera to iPad

Useful when on holiday to show your photos, or to back-up.

1 Use an iPad / SD Card Reader



2 Take the SD Card from your Camera, and put into the SD Card reader




3 Open up "Pictures / Photos" on your iPad



Hit the Photos icon

#### 4 Insert the Lightning Connector




1 Insert the Lightning connector from SD Card Reader into your iPad

2 You should see "Import" at the bottom row

3 ALL the photos on your SD Card will appear on the iPad


#### 5 Select the photos you want to Import



Click on the photos which you want to transfer to iPad.

A Blue Tick will appear on the corner of the photos selected.

## 6 Import



At the Top Corner, you can see "Import All" or Import Selected" - Hit Import Selected, and the 5 photos will go to the Photos section on your iPad.

## 7 The Ticks turn to Green to show that the Photos have been transferred



You then get the message "Delete imported photos from your Camera"

Hit "Keep" - you don't want to delete from your SD Card.

**NB --- With many cameras, you can use WiFi to transfer Photo from your Camera to your iPad, without any dongles. However, I have found that this is ok for a few photos, but if you want to select individual ones, see what you have selected, and also transfer many photos, then the SD Card Method is preferable.**
