Talking of learning....

- Start with just a few good books (or on line information).
- Read them from cover to cover and keep dipping back in.
- Three books/areas should be sufficient:
 - Technical
 - Pictorial
 - Historical/Philosophical
- Ongoing inspiration: Read all that wonderful new photography book and practice some of its ideas

Equipment Choice

- Choose what your photography needs
- Value proposition: Is your photographic ability worthy of the equipment?

Your style or comfort zone?

- A dichotomy
- Make a good image of any subject in any situation
- Style/preferred subject matter should refine those general skills

Camera in hand...

- Have a vision for the image/the day/the occasion/the location/the light
- Your social skills and photographic ethics
- Camera settings, +/- Evs, HDR, Panoramic
- Take multiple views (see Post P)
- Start early, finish late without losing sleep!

Post production

- Bin the blurred, the duplicates, the nothing shots
- Most images are improved by editing preferably to Lightroom level
- Bin those that don't improve

Your legacy

- Create a meaningful archive of your images
- Find opportunities to share your images, your ideas, your knowledge, yourself



Lenses with No Aperture Rings

The method used to adjust aperture can be selected using BUTTON/DIAL SETTING > APERTURE SETTING. When an option other than AUTO is selected, aperture can be adjusted using the front command dial.



Aperture control defaults to the front command dial, but can be reassigned to the rear command dial using ■ BUTTON/DIAL SETTING > COMMAND DIAL SETTING.

13. You also should see a green disc in the extreme lower left corner of the screen. If that green disc lights up steadily, the image is in focus; if it flashes, the camera was unable to focus. In that case, you can re-aim and see if the autofocus system does better from a different distance or angle.




Figure 2-13 - Green Brackets Indicating Sharp Focus

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
