There was general agreement that the photographer’s package at £7.49 a month was very reasonable value compared with the conventional path of buying full fat Photoshop. See [https://creative.adobe.com/plans/photography?store\\_code=gb](https://creative.adobe.com/plans/photography?store_code=gb) for this offer which is valid till the end of the month, but do read the Terms to understand what you are getting involved in. Photoshop Elements, or other editing software, will still be adequate for most of us.










Large Font for Titles

Small font for picture titles


Small pictures of all pages
