
A Tryptic.....

- Particularly good for digitally displayed images


No Rules But Some Guidelines

- Outer panels same size
- Accurate alignment
- Complimentary background
- Outer panels may illustrate aspects of the centre
- Vertical and random tryptics can be interesting

Tony's Tips

- Create component images as jpg
- Make them the correct size and aspect ratio
- Add hairline borders via Stroke
- Add drop shadows via Layer Style fx
- You have loads of pixels but watch out for sizing anomalies
