

Principal points made during the debate

By those tending to agree that "Britain is currently a democracy."

- Britain has freedom of expression in Press and Social Media
- Britain has free and fair elections.
- Britain has an open culture, with strong values of tolerance, pragmatism and good citizenship.
- The Europe referendum result is an an example of effective democracy.
- The quality of politicians in their personal behaviour and conduct is very poor.
- The performance of politicians in their political duties is very poor, for example the Labour Party in Opposition today.
- The performance of politicians in communicating to the electorate about major political issues such as Europe and Proportional Representation has been very poor.

By those tending to disagree that "Britain is currently a democracy."

- The absence of a strong Opposition in Parliament is a denial of democracy
- Membership of major political institutions is unrepresentative of the electorate; only 25% of electorate voted for current MPs and the Lords is unelected and unrepresentative.
- Communication between politicians and their electors is ineffective.
- Inequality in Britain, particularly economic but also social, is increasing.
- Fixed term Parliaments are in effect a 5 year dictatorship.
- Without Proportional Representation in some form Britain cannot be a democracy.

By those concerned to achieve an effective political system.

 Britain has a flawed democracy with many good points fundamentally and some significant and important shortcomings which need to be corrected.
